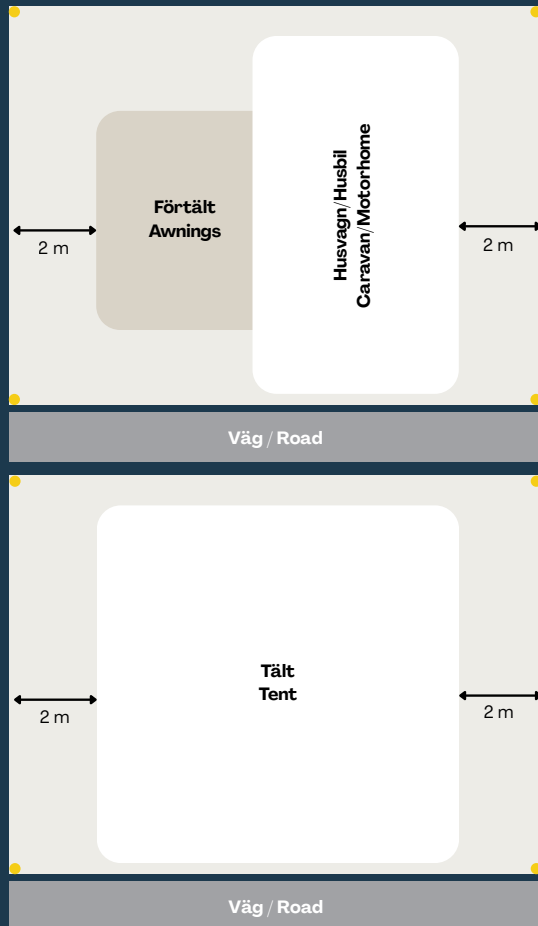


Welcome to our camping site!

To ensure everyone feels comfortable, we ask that you follow these rules.

Your camping spot

1 unit per spot is allowed: either 1 caravan with an awning and 1 car, 1 motorhome with an awning or 1 tent and 1 car. Please follow the designated placement shown below, and note that you must reverse into the spot.



Each spot is allowed 1 car on the camping site. Additional cars must be parked in the main parking lot and registered at reception when fees apply (April–November); otherwise, the standard fee will be charged.

Charging electric cars is not permitted at your spot; please use the designated charging stations on the main parking lot. Note that parking fees apply from April to November. Register your car at reception to receive free parking; otherwise, the standard fee will be charged.

All standard tent equipment of normal size is allowed, but hammocks are not permitted. Permanent tent structures may not be set up. Caravans and motorhomes must be registered as motor vehicles.

Permanent personal structures next to your tent, caravan, or motorhome—such as fences, storage sheds, or windbreak barriers—are not permitted. If you are unsure, please feel free to ask us. Also ensure that gas and electrical equipment have been tested and approved in accordance with current regulations.

Isaberg is not responsible for damage to or loss of guests belongings. Anyone who causes damage to buildings, equipment, or other people's property may be held liable for compensation.

The campsite must be vacated and cleaned before 12:00 noon on the day of departure, unless otherwise agreed.

Camping site

Drive or cycle carefully within the campsite so that everyone can feel safe and enjoy their stay. Our staff are available if you need assistance or if any issues arise. Please show consideration and respect for others at all times, and observe quiet hours between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.

Please leave shared facilities—such as toilets, the sauna, shower rooms, kitchens, and dishwashing areas—in the same condition you would like to find them. Pick up any litter and dispose of it in the nearest bin. We care about the environment and ask that you sort waste using the designated containers.

We appreciate it when dog owners show consideration and respect toward other guests. Please keep your dog on a short leash and take it outside the camping area for walks. We expect everyone to clean up after their dog. There is a separate dog swimming area, dog shower, and exercise yard on-site, all of which may be used free of charge.

Show children where it is safe to play and kick a ball. Our large playground and multi-sports arena are perfect for games and activities. However, throwing or kicking a ball among tents, caravans, and motorhomes is not allowed.

Black water (sewage) and grey water (from bathing, dishwashing, and laundry) must not be stored in open containers or discharged directly onto the ground. These must be emptied at our designated disposal stations.

Grilling is only permitted at designated barbecue areas or on your own grill at your campsite. Open fires directly on the ground and disposable grills are not allowed. Please use the designated bins at the waste station to dispose of charcoal.

Other

Temporary visitors must park in the main parking lot. Please note that parking is subject to a fee from April to November.

Sales activities in or around the campsite require permission from Isaberg.

Car washing is not permitted.
